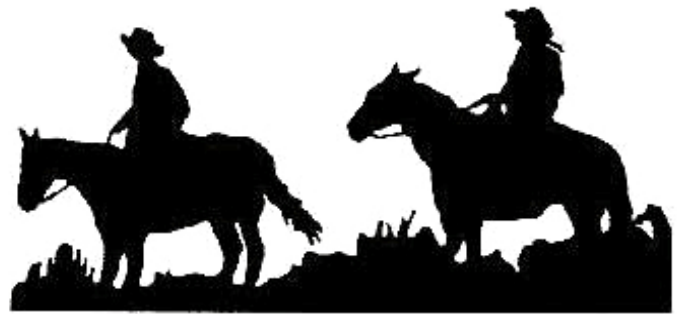

## FAMILY EVENT & CAMPGROUND RULES

1. Any breed of horse or pony acceptable  
No stallions or mares with foals allowed
2. Out of state riders required to have Coggins and Health Certificate for each horse
3. Dogs must be on a leash at all times. No dogs allowed on the trails during organized trail rides
4. Running or fast trotting of horses within the campground is prohibited
5. Public intoxication is prohibited  
Open containers of alcohol prohibited outside of the campsite. Be smart Be responsible and above all respect your neighbors.
6. An adult must accompany and supervise all minors (<18yrs old)
7. Quiet Hours 11:00 PM to 7:00 AM
8. All other State Park rules apply
