WHERE: Lake Village, IN. I-65 to Rt 10, West on Rt 10 to Meridian, South on Meridian (4miles) to field entrance. Or Rt 41 to Rt 10, East on Rt 10 to Meridian, then South for almost 4 miles.

WHEN: Registration, instructions, and pre-ride clinic 10:30. First riders on course at 11:00 am.

FEES: \$10/Rider. Non-members of NACMO will pay \$5 additional for one-day membership to cover insurance.

FACILITIES: This is a private property ride, and parking is in a partially shaded field used for cattle. There are no camping facilities, no water, no toilets. We will bring in a motorhome for limited toilet facilities, and we can carry in water if requested. Camping is permitted at the Grand Kankakee Marsh – ten miles away – and has water and toilet facilities. Call ahead for camping permission.

Pre-ride clinic and practice session will precede the ride. You will need an orienteering type compass (ex Silva 7), available at many camping supply stores for about \$10. There will be a few at the ride to buy or borrow.

CMO is a timed event. Find 5-10 markers using a map (provided), and your compass. Riders compete either individually or in teams of 2-6. Ride at any pace you like. We provide instructions and a practice marker before the ride. It's easy and fun to learn.

All rides are sanctioned by NACMO (Nat. Assoc. for Competitive. Mounted Orienteering), which provides regular newsletters and year-end awards in several categories at the state and national level. Cumulative records of points earned are kept on both horse and rider.
