Stoney Run Park is a county park that has a very nice equestrian trail. It does have primitive camping, however the horses are NOT allowed on the grass. They would have to stay by the trailers in the parking lot. Roxie Bank has graciously offered her property for those that would like to camp at her place, which is approximately 20 minutes from Stoney Run Park. Please call her for details of camping at her place @ 219-940-3044.

Due to the size of the park, we ask that you do not ride the park the weekend of the ride. You will need an orienteering type compass (ex; Silva 7), available at most camping supply stores for \$10-\$20. No digital compasses allowed.

CMO is a timed event. Find 5-10 markers using a map (provided), and your compass. Riders compete either individually or in teams of 2-6. Ride at any pace you like. We provide instructions and a practice marker before the ride. It's easy and fun to learn.

All rides are sanctioned by NACMO (National Association for Competitive Mounted Orienteering), which provides regular newsletters and year-end awards in several categories at the state and national level. Cumulative records of points earned are kept on both horse and rider.
