DIRECTIONS: From Mobile, On 65 North get off at Greenville exit 130 and take state route 10 east through Luverne to Troy. From 231 turn right off the northbound lane or left off the southbound lane onto Three Notch St. (Light at KFC). Go straight, 3.5 miles, thru downtown Troy(8 traffic lights) and continue to leave the city limits. The next light is a blinking caution light, turn left onto County Rd. 7708 Needmore Rd. (HDTR sign). Go 4 miles and HDTR is on the right.

From Atlanta, Birmingham, Take exit 9 off I-85 onto Taylor Road. Go South on Taylor Road for about 5 1/2 miles to Hwy 231. Turn left (South) on 231 for approx 21 miles to Meriweather Trail (about 1 miles south of Sikes and Kohn's clothing store on the right.) The turn is just past an abandon Rest Stop. Turn left on Meriweather Trail. Go about 5

miles. Turn right onto Hwy 49. There will be a NATRC at the turn. Go 3/10 of a mile and turn left. There will be another sign there. Go about 10 miles and the HOD will be on you left.
