Stephens State Forest in south-central Iowa is Iowa's largest state forest, with seven units totaling more than 15,500 acres in five counties. The forest's primary function is to provide an example of forest management for Iowa woodland species. First established in the 1930s with tree plantings by the Civilian Conservation Corp, Stephens State Forest is also a backcountry destination for outdoor enthusiasts interested in hiking, horseback riding, camping and hunting. Many of the trails travel deep into the woods with excellent wildlife watching opportunities. For more info see www.iowadnr.gov/Stephens

Directions: From I-35, take Hwy 34 east to US 65 at Lucas. Go south on US 65 for 1.9 miles to 467th Street (gravel road). Go west on gravel into park. Follow signs to equestrian campground.

Camping: Facilities are primitive, no hookups. Pit toilets and water hydrants are available at the campground. Dogs must be kept tied or on a leash at all times. The Iowa DNR has instituted a reservation system. One-half of all sites are reservable and can be reserved from 3 months to 2 days prior to arrival. Stabling: Horses must be stationary tied.

Ride Notes: A current negative Coggins Certificate is required on all horses. Out-of-state horses must have a current health certificate (within 30 days of event). Dogs are not allowed in management area, check-in and briefings areas and must be leashed at all times.

Ride Details: Late arrivals should make prior arrangements with ride management
