Directions: Google “Fort Leavenworth Hunt 251st Easton Kansas”, which will take you to the driveway. You should see a sign or ribbons.

From the west at Hwy 59 near Winchester, KS, take Hwy 192 East approximately 8.8 miles to 251st St. Turn right (south) onto 251st St, ride camp is 1.25 miles south on the gravel road at the intersection with Bayle Rd.

From Leavenworth, Kansas: As you depart the Missouri River Bridge, continue straight on the 4-lane, pass the Fort Leavenworth gate and the Federal Penitentiary. The road has too many names! US 73 N, KS 7 N, Amelia Earhart Dr, Commercial Street. Go 8.5 miles west and turn left onto KS 192, also called Easton Road. As you are leaving the town of Easton, bear left at the Y on KS 192 and from here go 2.6 miles to 251st St. Turn left (south) from a straight stretch of road. There will be a sign or ribbons here. Ride camp is 1.25 miles south on the gravel road at the intersection with Bayle Road.

This ride is being held on the hunt country of the Fort Leavenworth Hunt. It is entirely on private land and we ride at the pleasure of **multiple** landowners. **PLEASE** be extremely considerate of the land.

Helmets required. The trails have been mowed for many years, suitable for riding side by side in many places, passing is easy, mostly dirt with intermittent rocky spots. Horses with well-conditioned hooves can ride barefoot easily. There are many creek crossings, a few ponds, and water tanks placed in strategic places. There will be 2 loops each day. There are some fast, flat portions and slower hilly trails.

All who pre-register will have access to the trail map for downloading ahead of time **and Receive an Invitation to Hunt with** Fort Leavenworth Hunt at any normal scheduled hunt from the time we receive your entry! What a great way to pre-ride some of the trails, condition your horse and try something new!

Camping: \$10 per night per person payable to LFA.

Ride Camp not available to competitors and volunteers until 7 am Friday, April 9 without special permission. If this presents a problem, contact Lucy Hirsch 816-830-8816. For a generous donation to LFA, special arrangements can be made to camp Thursday and/or Sunday nights.

Camp is a hay field with a graveled lane down the middle edged by brushy trees and cedars. There is a porta-pot and a frost free water hydrant, please wash horses in road and use buckets if there is a line. There are 2 buildings; one with heat and electrical outlets, chairs and tables. Please haul out your own trash. During the ride you may pile your manure or put it under trees; before you leave, please scatter any hay or manure that would kill out the grass. Phone coverage varies but does exist. **Trails closed on Friday** - only a short loop and the roads are open for pre-ride on Friday. See the ride secretary for a map.

Management will park you as camping space is very limited. Let Lucy Hirsch know if you have special camping request (huge rig, next to friend, etc.). We hope to have a campfire in a central area.

Stabling: Any stabling method allowed by NATRC rules is allowed. However, space may be limited by management if needed.

Current Health Papers (within 30 days of this event) *REQUIRED* On All Out-of-State Horses

•Be prepared to show original health and/or Coggins papers at check-in. •Pets must be tethered or leashed at all times. •No pets at briefings or meals. •No smoking on trails. •No open fires at your campsite. •P&R workers must be 12 years of age or older

B2 Ride for Novice, CP, Open check-in with ride secretary starts Saturday at 4 pm; check-in of horses starts Saturday at 4:30 pm
