
# Brown County Park Management Horse Trails 2012

#### **General Restrictions:**

#### Please...

Obey trail signs and closures; stay on marked bridle trails.

- No pets allowed on County Park lands.
- Yield right-of-way to all trail users.
- No grazing along trails.
- Walk, trot, canter—no racing.
- Attach pass to outer clothing or horse bridle so pass is visible at all times.
- Report trail hazards, violations and incidents to County Park Staff.
- Bring your own water.

#### It is unlawful...

- To pick wildflowers and destroy, molest or deface trees, disturb wild animals, plants or natural features.
- To not clean up all manure and litter.
- To leave marked trails.
- To solicit business of any nature, place signs or distribute hand bills.
- To camp.
- For horses & trailers to be in undesignated parking lots and developed park areas.



Trail Hours: Daily trail hours are posted at individual trail facilities. Trails usually open mid-April and close in early November, weather pending.

# Fees for County Trails (Neshota & Reforestation Camp):

A County trail pass is required for all persons age 16 years or older.

- Daily passes are \$3.00 and can be purchased at the Trailheads.
- Annual passes are \$15.00 and can be purchased at the Trailhead or at the below vendor:

# Fees for Wisconsin State Trails (Fox River Trail):

An Annual State Trail Pass or a Daily Pass is required for horseback riders age 16 years or older.

# **Directions to the Neshota:**

PARK ROAD

Take I-43 to Bellevue, turn East on Hwy. 29 in Poland, turn South on County Trunk "T", then left on Park Road. About 15 miles from Green Bay.

## **Facilities**

- 2 miles of marked bridle trails.
- Toilet is available at shelter.

# **Directions to the Reforestation Camp:**

Take Hwy. 41 to exit #176 (Suamico, County B). Turn West on County B and go 3.5 miles to Pine Lane. Turn right (North) on Pine Lane to Sunrise Road. Turn right (East) on Sunrise Road. Trailhead and parking lot will be on the left.



# **Facilities**

- 8 miles of marked bridle trails. Trails vary in width from 5 feet to 25 feet. Mostly sandy and flat.
- Trailside toilet is available.

Drive-through parking area—park on either side and exit down the center.

# **Directions to the Fox River Trail:**

The southern portion of the trail South of Highway 96 in the Village of Greenleaf allows horseback riding on the gravel surface. Horses are permitted only on the trail as posted from Klaus Street in Greenleaf south to the Brown County line. Trailer parking is available at designated access point.

### **Facilities**

- 6 miles of bridle trails.
- Trailside toilet is available at Klaus Street parking access.
