

- Drive 1.1 miles up Monument Peak Road
- Drive .3 miles to Santiam Horse Camp.



The Monument Peak Trail System is located on the Santiam State Forest. It is approximately 12 miles in length. Horses, mountain bikers, and hikers are allowed on these non-motorized, multiuse trails.

There are two staging areas for the trail system. The first is located at the beginning of the Monument Peak Road where the pavement turns to gravel. The second is located at the Santiam Horse Camp. The Monument Peak Trail system is growing. You may see new trails currently under construction.

Individual trails may be closed at any time due to active forest management operations, ongoing project work, or to prevent trail damage. To help protect the trails, please avoid using them during periods of heavy rainfall. Check the trail signs, forest information boards and the Santiam State Forest website for trail
