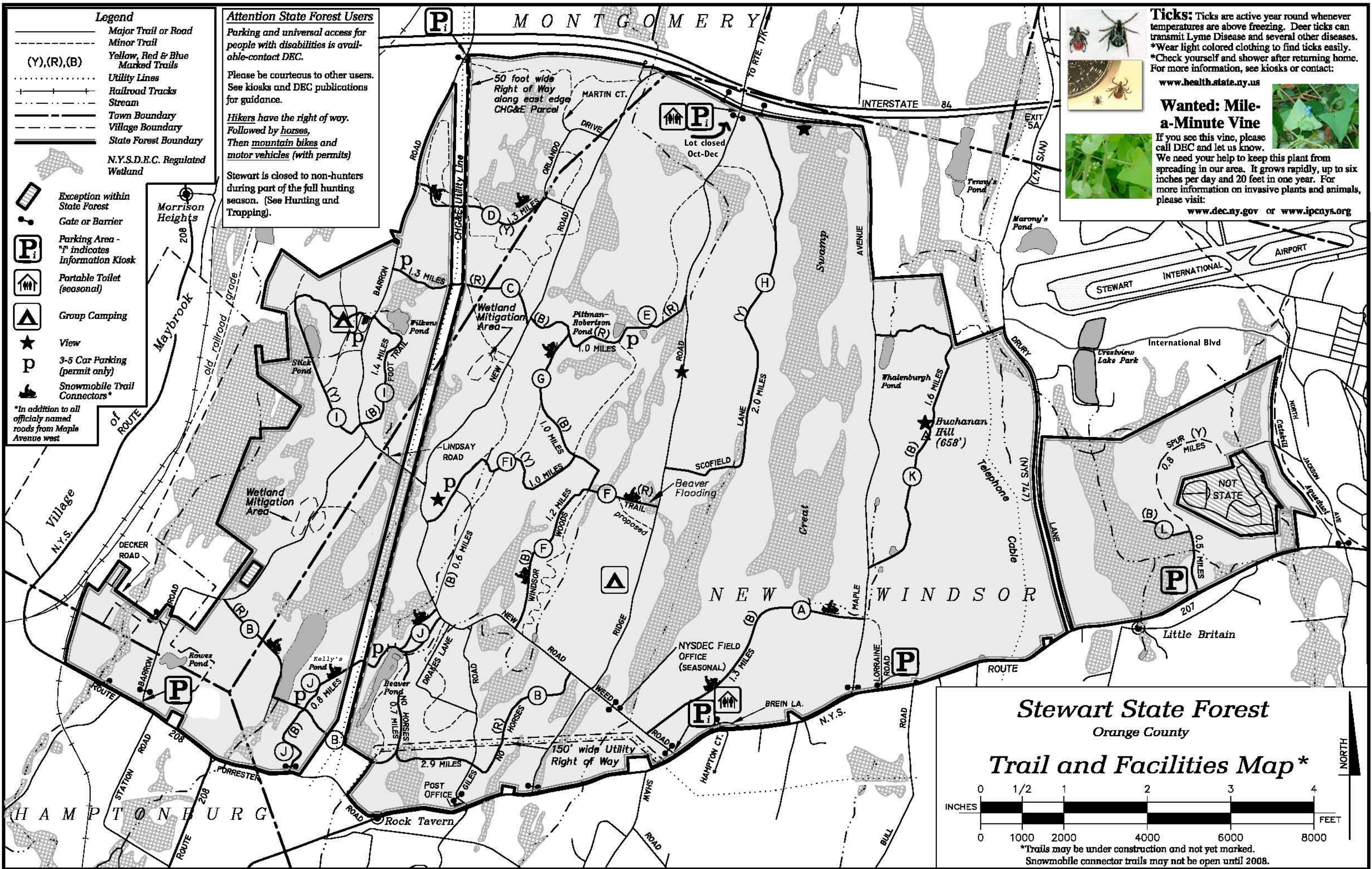
**Attention State Forest Users**
